1	Exacta: 1-3/1-2-3, \$4. Tri: 1-3/1-2-3/1-2-3-4, \$4. Pick 3: 1-3/1-2/1-7, \$4. Super: 1-3/1-2-3/1-2-3-4/1-2-3-4, \$.80. Pick 4: 1-3/1-2/1-7/6-8, \$8. DD: 1-3/1-2, \$4.
CALMCOOLNCOLLECTED (#3) Cantcatchthiscat (#1) Sir Argento (#2)	Has been well bet in each of his three starts this year, finishing second in all, he gets a little more rest between starts today, can make amends. Three-year-old facing older but he does exit a stakes field, worked well after that race and looks set for a big effort. Only three lengths behind the top choice in a race he looked to need last.
2	Exacta: 1-2/1-2-3, \$4. Tri: 1-2/1-2-3/all, \$6. Super: 1-2/1-2-3/all/all, \$2.40. Pick 3: 1-2/1-7/3-6-8, \$6.
CANDY CABALLO (#2) Veritas Aequitas (#1) Adios Jojo (#3)	Speedy colt couldn't keep with some of the top older sprinters on the grounds last but he figures to control the early pace in here, have to catch him. Favored over similar last but he couldn't overcome a wide trip on what appeared to be a rail favoring surface, he moves inside, expect big try. Nice score in his first route effort last, hard to separate from the top two picks.

CANTLAY (#7) Schoolofhardknocks (#1) Cnady Chamer (#5)	Didn't get the best of trips in his debut when facing tougher, he worked well after that race from the gate, drops into a maiden claiming race, seems most likely. First time starter is bred to be quick early, he looks ready off a long string of workouts and should come out running. \$4,000 yearling purchase worked very well from the gate recently, consider.

PLATINUM DIVA (#6) Lucy L (#8) Thirsty Nic (#3)	Hasn't been able to win while being heavily bet in each of her last two but she drops in price and should get another hot pace to run at in the stretch. Forced a fast pace against the boys and tired in her last but she is back against the girls and has good tactical speed to overcome her wide post draw. Dull try last but she did run well around two turns back in May, maybe.
5	Exacta: 4-5/1-4-5, \$4. Tri: 4-5/1-4-5/1-4-5-6-7, \$6. Pick 3: 1-4-5/7/6, \$1.50. Super: 4-5/1-4-5/1-4-5-6-7/1-4-5-6-7, \$2.40. Pick 4: 1-4-5/7/6/4-6-7, \$4.50.
BROTHER O'BRIEN (#5) J.B. Books (#4) Right Hand Ryder (#1)	Tim McCanna trained runner just failed to win his third race in a row last, he clearly is going very well right now, one to beat. Stretch runner wasn't far behind the top choice last after having some trouble at the start, he again appears a big late danger. Ran two big races for wins here last year, should be close by throughout.
6	Exacta: 7/1-2-5, \$3. Tri: 7/1-2-5/1-2-5-6, \$4.50. Pick 3: 7/6/4-6-7, \$1.50. Super: 7/1-2-5/1-2-5-6/all, \$3.60. Pick 4: 7/6/4-6-7/4-7, \$3.
ALOHA BREEZE (#7) Precise Timing (#1) LaPush (#2)	Twelve time winner at Emerald was never in danger of losing her last when 1/2, she draws perfectly today, obviously very hard to bet against. Couldn't reach contention while wide last but the inside appeared the place to be that day and her race one back gives her a shot. Second to the top choice in this race last year, she must be considered.

MATTIE GOINCOASTAL (#6) Cruised to an easy score in her debut two weeks ago, she earned a good speed figure for a two-year-old in July in that race, nice post draw, should repeat.

Pure Dynamite (#1) Couldn't reach the top choice in her debut but she did run well for second, can improve.

Champagne Delight (#5) Exits the same heat as the top two, she is another who should improve.

CAPS AND CARNAGE (#7) Winner of all three of his starts, including the most recent by nearly twenty lengths obviously is pretty talented, deserves to be favored.

Diamond Dasher (#6) Sped to the lead and never looked back in his debut with a nice score, owner/trainer have won many stakes at Emerald, may add yet another stakes win.

Ziwhat (#4) Third despite significant trouble in his debut, he could be the one.

 Super: 4-7/1-4-7/1-4-5-7/1-3-4-5-7, \$1.60. Pick 3: 4-7/2-7/2-3-7, \$6.

TAX CODE (#7) Set a slow pace and drew away in the stretch in the Budweiser, he can act from on or off the lead early, post couldn't be better, extra distance shouldn't be an issue.

Slew's Tiz Whiz (#4) Four time consecutive winner of this race ran a better than looks race last (wide against a golden rail while closing into a slow pace), should be set for best.

Si That Tiger (#1) Unlucky to draw the one hole but he clearly can't be ignored.

ROBIN RACER (#2) 2025 Gottstein winner made a nice run late when second in the Auburn, he clearly will be helped by the move to a route, choice.

Chase (#7) Held on gamely in the Auburn for a wire to wire win, he is bred to like routing and appears to be getting better with every start.

Now Cato (#6) Also in good form off a nice score, he should be in the battle throughout.

Falling Leaves (#7) Speedy miss set a rocket pace and wasn't able to hold off the top choice, Alvarado will try his hand in slowing her down early today, wire to wire danger.

Alluring Valentine (#2) Another who is bred to love two-turns, Krigger is back riding.
